Road names for land east of Sudbury Road

The Council has been contacted by Bellway Homes concerning the new development east of Sudbury Road. They have suggested that the development might be called Willow Park, but they have asked to let them know if we agree to this, and to offer names for the new adoptable roads within the estate. There at least 11 of these, so it would be worth giving some consideration to a suitable group of names that has not been used elsewhere in other new developments in Halstead.

The area around the development is called Star Stile. This could be applied to the whole development.

The Town Clerk has consulted the History Society which has come up with the suggestion of calling the area Artists' corner and supplied the names of a large number of local artists. The advantage is that these will not have been used before:

Edward Bingham 19th century



Alternatively the roads could be named to reflect the former habitat of the species of the area:

Natterjack Toad
Great crested newt
Muntjac
Dormouse
Hedgehog
Fox
Bat
Fieldmouse
Rabbit
Wren
Bluetit
Swift
Squirrel
Badger
Deer
Hare

Another suggestion is that we name the roads after deceased cricketers, or as we are a floral town, we could use flower names selected by HiB.

Recommendation: that HTC agrees on names to put forward to Bellway developers.
