To provide an update on the purchase of a flat clock to commemorate the Queen's platinum Jubilee to be installed on the Halstead Library building

Following the decision made at Full Council on 16 March, the Clerk has made an application for planning and listed building consent to install a flat clock on the Halstead Library building, to commemorate the Queen's platinum Jubilee. In addition, the clock company have measured the space and checked the viability of connection of the mechanism for the clock through the wall. Their report should be available by the time of the meeting.

Councillors are reminded that the cost of the clock and its installation will be £4300 plus around £500 in costs associated with the planning application.

As planning may take some time to consider the application, and may not even allow the clock to be installed, it cannot be guaranteed that the clock will be in place for the Jubilee weekend.

The question of payment for the clock has been discussed between the Lead for Finance and the Clerk, and it is suggested that this be paid for out of Capital reserves.
