Communication with residents

1. Invite schools to compete as follows
 - a. Ramsey school – a logo for the campaign
 - b. Primary schools posters for the campaign
2. Produce leaflet for drop to all households to advertise
 - a. Key messages from agreed list to encourage resident involvement
 - b. Advertise events held in conjunction with Public garden events and others
 - c. Promote Community Solar scheme
 - d. Contact scouts/guides/HAPPY/post office to distribute
 - Donate/Pay?/seek social media support/new section of HTC website?
 - e. Source gazebo, make bunting from logo/posters/prepare posters
 - f. Source volunteers to assist thro established groups and social media
 - g. Contact BDC, ECC for support/promo materials

Review HTC Policies

3. Review equipment and prospect for conversion to environmentally friendly options

Public Transport
