Finance Report on November

Income and Expenditure

It is good to be able to report that the car parks are once again performing way above budget, and income is now £10,000 above budget, and that the Queens Hall bookings are in line with budget. It is pleasing to see that most expenditure is well in line with budget predictions. The current surplus showing income over expenditure after 8 months of the financial year is £43,116.

Earmarked Reserves

The repairs to the path in St Andrews churchyard have been paid for from the churchyard maintenance EMR.

Capital Reserves

Capital Reserves have been used for the Owl meeting device and the single yellow line at Trinity Street, and also to buy a new PC for the Receptionist so far this year.
