To consider updating and refurbishing the external decoration at the public toilets

It has been observed that the public toilets building has been looking a bit tired, shabby and uncared for.

The moss has been removed from the roof, and some rotten wood replaced. It is proposed to provide a more modern look, and to make the toilets more accessible for those with visual impairment.

It is suggested that large symbols be placed on each door indicating who can use it, and that then the doors should be repainted, either each in a different colour, say blue, yellow and red, so that all users find it easy to identify that these are public toilets, and which one they can use; or the door should be repainted all in one colour but something different from the current glaring green. For symbols we suggest option 1, after the doors have been painted.

The cost of the symbols will be £120 + VAT

The cost of the paint will be £60

Recommendation : that HTC approves the upgrade of the public toilets.
